CLIMATE > Typically mediterranean and set in the sub-region of Vidigueira, where the climatic conditions are the most temperate of Alentejo and provide an excellent microclimate for the production of quality wines.

SOIL > Poor land, predominantly of granite and schist. Great pedological potential for the cultivation of vines and for obtaining excellent wines.

VARIETIES > Antão Vaz, Arinto and Alvarinho

The varieties Antão Vaz, Arinto and Alvarinho are trellised in the vertical shoot position, in a plot that is slightly exposed to the east, with an east/west orientation.

ANALYTIC PARAMETERS

Alcohol Content > 12,5% Total Acidity > 6,100 g/dm3 Volatile Acidity > 0,25 g/dm3 Residual Sugars > 3,7 g/dm3 pH > 3,28

VINIFICATION > Manual harvest in 12 kg boxes. After a selection on a vibrating sorting table, the grapes underwent cold maceration. Fermentation took place in small capacity stainless steel tanks, at a temperature of 16°C, for 21 days.

AGING > Five months in stainless steel tanks and two months in the bottle.

TASTING NOTES Citrine green in colour. Rich in fruit with exuberant tropical notes. Freshness, minerality and a good volume in the mouth with a balanced acidity.
