COLOR: Yellow

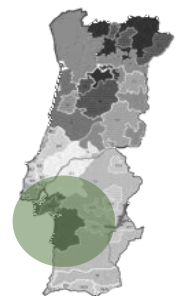
AROMA: Tropical fruits, ripe mango with the characteristic freshness of the viosinho grape variety.
