## HERDADE DO ROCIM RED WINE | ALICANTE BOUSCHET 2018

## REGION: VIDIGUEIRA | ALENTEJO PRODUCER: HERDADE DO ROCIM VITICULTURE: CATARINA VIEIRA | AMÂNDIO CRUZ WINEMAKING: CATARINA VIEIRA | PEDRO RIBEIRO

CLIMATE > Typically mediterranean, in the winegrowing sub-region of Vidigueira, where the climatic conditions are the most temperate of Alentejo and provide an excellent microclimate for the production of quality wines.

SOIL > Poor land, predominantly of schist. Great pedological potential for the cultivation of vines and and to produce excellent wines.

## VARIETIES > Alicante Bouschet

The Alicante Bouschet is trellised in vertical shoot position, with west exposure. The rows have an east/west orientation.

## ANALYTIC PARAMETERS

Alcohol Content > 14,0% Total Acidity > 5,800 g/dm3 Volatile Acidity > 0,56 g/dm3 Residual Sugars > 2,4 g/dm3 pH > 3,56

VINIFICATION > Manual harvest into 12 kg boxes. At the winery, the grapes were once again sensible triaged on a vibrating sorting table, fully destemmed and lightly crushed. Fermentation in stone lagar. Foot trodden.

AGING > Aging took place in french oak barrels, for 12 months. Bottle aging for six months.

TASTING NOTES > Deep concentrated ruby colour. Enticing aroma of black fruits and a well balanced minerality with the spicy notes from aging in barrel. Well structured tannins and balanced acidity, allowing a good bottle aging.
